STANDARD 14 - DISCRETE MATHEMATICS

Core-Plus Mathematics is a 4-year curriculum that replaces the traditional sequence with courses that each feature interwoven strands of algebra and functions, statistics and probability, geometry and trigonometry, and discrete mathematics.

An NCTM report, Discrete Mathematics and the Secondary Mathematics Curriculum (Dossey, 1991), outlined the discrete mathematics topics appropriate for grades 7-12. The Curriculum and Evaluation Standards for School Mathematics (1989) was intended to set standards for what mathematics all students should know, understand and be able to do in three grade bands, K-4, 5-8, and 9-12.

MA in Mathematics, Teaching Emphasis

Although the main objects of study in discrete mathematics are discrete objects, analytic methods from continuous mathematics are often employed as well. In university curricula, "Discrete Mathematics" appeared in the 1980s, initially as a computer science support course; its contents were somewhat haphazard at the time.

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
